## <u>LATEST RESULTS – Congratulations to all who took part in the following events</u>

#### Saturday 10th December – Extremely Jolly 7.5 mile Run at Escot Park

**Claire Sorensen** ran in fancy dress with 300 runners in this race in the beautiful location that offered a variety of trails, mud, woodland tracks, paths, streams, quaint bridges, fields and water crossings with a unique 30 metre waterslide enroute. Claire thoroughly enjoyed the slippy & slidey event finishing in **1.36.37**.

#### Sunday 11th December - Telford 10km (inc. England Masters qualifying event)

**Jenny Reay** travelled 200 miles north to take part in the Telford 10km that included the selection race for the England Masters 10km team. Racing in sub zero temperatures Jenny continued her superb recent racing form finishing **2nd in her age category** in an excellent time of **42.10**. This means that Jenny has qualified for the England Masters team to race in the Chester 10km in March 2023. Jenny becomes the 14th Exmouth Harrier to represent England Masters in the past few years.

#### Sunday 11th December – Plymtrail Marathon

**Chris Murrin** ran his 105th Marathon but the start of the race was delayed by 60 minutes due to the frosty & slippery conditions. Chris said afterwards "It was the worst conditions under foot I've ever run with sheet ice in several stretches that meant we were only just able to walk in places". Despite the tricky conditions Chris managed to finish the 26.2 miles in an amazing time of **4.28.08**.

#### Sunday 11th December – Age UK Exmouth Santa Claus 5km

**Craig Butler** donned a Santa Claus suit to take part in this event that started and finished in the gardens opposite Exmouth pavilion. Craig pushed into the lead along the seafront to Orcombe Point and stretched it out back to the finish winning in an impressive time of **20.54**.

#### Sunday 18th December – Wellington Monument 10km Race

Four Harriers completed this mostly road race challenge with one mile of woodland bridle paths that encircle the iconic Wellington Monument. The monument is normally visible from the M5, but the 175ft Obelisk could only be seen once up close at arms distance due to being engulfed by rain clouds.

The race is described by the organisers Taunton AC as "Quite possibly the hilliest and toughest 10km course on the Blackdown Hills". The 250 runners started at The Catherine Wheel Public House in the village square at Hemyock with a gentle half mile through the village before acsending over 600ft in just 2.5 miles. Once around the Monument they retraced their steps back to the village and finished at Hemyock County Primary School.

The conditions were extremely wet and very tricky underfoot in places which unfortunately meant the expected amazing views across Devon and Somerset were blocked by the low lying rain clouds.

**Ray Elston** (recovering from a recent illness) was on hand to cheer the Harriers through the village at the start and finish.

#### **Sunday 18th December – Torrington Christmas Caper**

**Simon Minting** and **Dawn Teed** tackled this 9 miles of mud, forest trails, rivers and hills that is generally considered to be one of the most challenging multi-terrain runs in the South West. The race was organised by Torrington AAC and has previously been voted Devon Race of the Year.

Due to the cold, icy & wet conditions parts of the course had to be changed at the last moment. There was one part that had slabs of broken ice where the runners had to pick their way carefully through the icy water making their legs completely numb. The course was well marshalled with warnings of the icy hazards plus the excellent Christmas pud, cream and mulled wine for all finishers meant that the runners survived and recovered quickly afterwards.
