Racing early in 2023 Exmouth Harriers had 29 runners competing in 6 different Westcountry locations & 1 Harrier was in Surrey in very changeable weather conditions on Sunday 8th & Sunday 15th January

Sunday 8th January – Running Events Devon's Winter Plym Trail - Day 2

Chris Murrin ran his 107th Marathon with the first half of the race in horrible conditions including hail, thunder & lightning and a strong gusty wind. Chris battled through the tough conditions into the lead at 10 miles and then pushed on during the rest of the race to finish in first position in a fabulous time of 4.07.57.

Sunday 8th January - South West Cross Country Championships at the RNAS Merryfield (near Ilton, Somerset)

Rob Ellis and Jimmy Joy ran in the South West Inter Counties Cross Country Championships in sunshine but it was a proper mud bath for the run over a 4.2 mile slightly undulating course. Jimmy collected an individual bronze medal in the M60 Age Category and Rob was 4th out of 6 counters for the Senior Devon County team who took the team Silver medals.

Sunday 8th January - Sir Walter Raleigh Round 1/2 Marathon

Six Harriers including three members of the Kelly family ran in the Half Marathon hosted by Climb South West that visited the birthplace of Sir Walter Raleigh and the countryside where he spent time as a child. The route started and finished in Budleigh Salterton and included quiet back lanes, unsurfaced county roads, little known footpaths, the Otter valley, High Peak, the Jurassic Coast and a dismantled railway. In very muddy & challenging conditions Sam Kelly retained his title from 2022 winning in an amazing time of 1.28.11 with Sister Alice only 2 positions behind in 3rd overall and 1st Lady finisher (also retaining her title from 2022) in 1.44.56, Mum Nicola completed the family trio in 69th position in 2.36.55.

Sunday 15th January – Westward League XC at Westward Ho!

Seven hardy Harriers - Hannah Bown, Sarah Baldwin, Alison White, Rob Ellis, Oli White, Anthony Hatchard and Jimmy Joy raced in the 4th of the Westward League Cross Country events adjacent to the beach at Westward Ho! There was a biting North-westerly wind with a lot of the course under water and some extremely muddy sections to negotiate. The Woman's 5km race set off first with Hannah and Sarah just able to keep upright around the 2 laps finishing in 15th and 63rd positions respectively but unfortunately Alison fell twice (at the same place on both of the laps) picked herself up and ran through to the finish in 64th position.

In the Men's 3 lap race of 8km the heavens opened up and the wind picked up to gale force halfway around which added extra hazards to an already challenging course. Rob was in the chasing pack of 3 runners for the first two laps but just got outpaced on the final lap to finish in a fantastic 8th position. Oli was next in for Harriers in 22nd position followed by Anthony who lost a few places when he fell (sliding along in the mud for what seemed like 30 feet) finishing in 34th position. Jimmy completed the Harriers male quartet with his usual smile as he crossed the line in 55th position.

After 4 of the 6 races Hannah is 3rd in the W40 category, Rob is 2nd in the Senior Men's category, Anthony is leading the M45 category and Jimmy is leading the M60 category.
