#### **Sunday 5th February – Exmouth Express**

On a really beautiful morning with wall-to-wall blue sky and sunshine Exmouth Harriers hosted the Exmouth Express 5 Mile Race on Sunday 5th February over two laps of the Exmouth seafront starting & finishing adjacent to the Foxholes Car Park.

The popular race was held for the first time since 2019 due the seafront flood prevention works and the Covid-19 restrictions.

Harrier's Tom Merson and Oli White led the race from gun to tape with Tom pushing ahead on the 2nd lap of the seafront to take the top spot in 25.51 with Oli 2nd in 27.13. The podium places were completed with South West Road Runners Gwylym Gibson finishing 3rd in 27.25.

The first female finisher was Victoria Hill of South West Road Runners in 11th position overall in a superb time of 30.09. Okehampton AC's Claudine Benstead was 2nd in 33.09 with Dani Water of South Devon AC 3rd in 35.06.

There were 87 finishers with lots of very positive comments about the race from the runners; everyone was pleased that the race has been resurrected in 2023 and they were looking forward to the 2024 event.

Harriers Chairman Nigel Dupain said after the race "Well done to all of the runners and thanks to everyone who helped make it such a great event, with special thanks to Race Director Craig Butler. A great event with a really good atmosphere all round".

#### **Sunday 5th February – 4 Trigs**

Six Harriers (Sam Kelly, James Kelly, Amanda McCann, Nicola Kelly, Lisa Hatchard & Bob Keast) tackled the 4 Trigs - a tough off-road fell run of 17 miles in stunning conditions with fantastic scenery around East Devon's Sid Valley starting and finishing on Sidmouth seafront.

Sam was first finisher in 2.09.11 and brother James was 3rd in 2.22.38.

#### Sunday 12th February – Westward League Cross Country at Central Park Plymouth

This was the penultimate race in the six race Winter series. The final race in the series is at Redruth on Sunday 5th March.

Harriers leading Cross Country runner Rob Ellis wasn't fazed by his car breaking down on the way to the event. Rob did his 2 mile warm-up run in lyybridge whilst waiting for a lift to the event in Plymouth cutting it fine to get to the start in time for the race. After recovering his composure Rob ran superbly to finish in third place which puts him in a very strong position to finish in the top three in the overall series. After the current dry spell the course was much less muddy than in previous years. Harriers Anthony Hatchard who finished in the top 30 for the first time in this years series said after the race "The dry conditions made it super fast and it hurt but in a good way, great running from everyone"

#### Sunday 12th February – The Exeter 1/2 Marathon

This race was hosted by City Community Trust who organise events to support a range of sports participation and wellbeing activities for people of all ages across the community. It was run over a great flat, traffic free course run on the footpaths and cycle tracks around the River Exe and Exeter Canal. Racing in his first 1/2 Marathon in a Harriers vest Eduardo Rosete finished in 55th position in a marvellous time of 1.41.57 with Rachel Sanders consolidating her recent excellent form in local 5km parkruns by finishing in 108th position in 1.50.41
