Sunday 3rd September – Woodbury Common Trail 10km Run

It was the 2nd Budleigh Lions Club Woodbury Common 10k. 20 Harriers competed in a field of 141 runners. The race was the final race in the Clubs Inter Race Challenge. Full results to be announced later in the year.

It was hot conditions that made for spectacular views across the common. The route started at Withycombe Football Pitches, skirted Dalditch Plantation, Squabmore Resevior, Bystock Nature reserve, heading north on the East Devon Way before penetrating Hayes Wood to loop back to the start.

A challenging route that had it all. Hills, river crossings, livestock, boggy patches, trips, falls and some navigation irregularities. Some faired the conditions better than others. **Alice Kelly** and **Scott Jamieson** managed to stick one foot into a clay puddle up to the knee. Leaving both with a clay boot to take around three miles of the course. **Scott** stuck his other foot in another hole to try and evenly cover mud around his body with a measure of success.

The top four were very fast indeed. However they didn't have to temporarily halt during the race as two horse riders directed the race to stop to avoid spooking thier horses. Don't think they would have been caught, and luckily the horses were fine and in quick time the race got back under way.

The elevation over the six miles was over 800ft. **Dana Kaelin**, normally used to conquering the Swiss Alps nonchalantly said "only 250m" before the start, however even she admitted it was a tough six miles at the end.

Harry Lyons and Kay Douglas were seen cheerfully chatting throughout the course. This running friendship appeared to have ceased in the last 100m, which they both completed in about 9.99seconds. The photo finish had **Harry** as the winner of that battle although **Kay** is still mulling over asking for a stewards enquiry.

The mutual support from the club made it a special morning. And it was good to see the chairman on the course cheering us all on. Some were asking why **Nigel** was not racing, he informed me that he had already done 20 miles that morning by 9am and therefore couldn't run. **Scott Jordan**, came along to support, he was due to race but unfortunately has suffered the well know medical condition "UBI" (Unintended Beer Injury). We hope you get better soon **Scott**.

The only prizes were for the top three male and female. The Harriers scooped first and second in both. Well done to **Sam Kelly, Alice Kelly, Simon Minting** and **Dana Kaelin**.

A great event with an old school running event feel to it. One for the calendar next year. Well done all. **Scott Jamieson**
