Training - don't forget that all sessions will now start from the tennis centre unless an "away day" session is planned outside of Exmouth



Saturday 28th October – Lone Wolf, Dartington

Matt Harrison & Dana Kalin ran in this unique off-road running event that was based on the Dartington Estate with a 7k course of undulating terrain, taking in the natural beauty of the Dart Valley and woodlands. Runners had one hour to complete the 7k course and then had whatever time left in the hour to rest before setting off again to complete the course a second time... then a third... and every hour until only the "Lone Wolf" remained. Dana said after the race "What a tough and incredibly muddy race".

Sat. & Sun. 28th & 29th October - OMM (Original Mountain Marathon), Eryri / Snowdonia Lisa & Anthony Hatchard competed together in this 2-day event; probably UK's biggest mountain race that has shaped the UK outdoor running community since 1968. It is a self-reliant 2-day journey through some of the UK's finest mountain terrain; a true test of mountain craft, resilience & sense of humour. They ran in the Medium Score event and covered 21 miles with almost 6,500ft elevation gain. They were 196th pair to finish overall in the Medium Score event in 10.27.23 and were the 42nd pair to finish in the Medium Score Mixed event. Lisa said afterwards "It was brutal but brilliant".

Saturday 4th November – Devon Trail ½ Marathon, Woodbury Common

Matt Harrison ran in the Devon Trail 1/2 Marathon. The 13.1 mile was over two laps of a course on the very best paths around Woodbury Common with some cracking trails, some tough little climbs & even a couple of stream crossings. The start and finish was in the stunning grounds of Bicton College.

Saturday 4th November - Climb South West's 8 & 5 Trigs Ultras, East Devon

Four Harriers ran in this self navigating event between 5 or 8 OS triangulation points located on some of the highest areas in East Devon. Both routes started and finished on the Budleigh Salterton seafront and during the day they benefitted from some far reaching views to Berry Head, Portland and Dartmoor. On their way they took in the trig points at High Peak, Weston Cliff, Buckton Hill, Beacon Hill, Aylesbeare, Woodbury, Black Hill and West Down Beacon. A basic understanding of navigation was required; the 8 trigs total distance was approximately 33 miles and the shorter 5 trigs route (that avoided the biggest hills on the Eastern part of the course) was just over 21 miles.

Amazingly despite the exceptionally wet conditions underfoot **Sam Kelly** was 1st finisher in the 8 Trigs in a new course record of 4 hours and 21 minutes.

In the 5 Trigs **Dana Kalin** was 3rd overall and 1st Lady to finish in 3.56.00 plus **Neil Collins** & **Scott Jordan** finished the 5 Trigs in 4.36.00.

Sunday 5th November – TCS NYC Marathon, New York

James Kelly had a fabulous run in the Worlds biggest Marathon finishing in the top 500 out of over 50,000 runners in a superb time of 2.49.25 that equates to 6.28 minute miling for the 26.2 miles through the 5 boroughs of New York. **James** said after the finish "A tough day but a brilliant race and atmosphere".

The course headed out on roads and returned on the Tarka Trail, including a run through a tunnel. Overall the course is moderately flat, with only three small inclines.
